

**MINUTES**

A special meeting of the City Council of the City of Pinehurst was held on April 29, 2020 at 5:30p.m. by teleconference via GoToMeeting. Mayor Dan Mohon established a quorum by calling roll. Sarah McClendon, T.W. Permenter, Cynthia Adams, and J. Michael Shahan were present. Councilman John Zerko was absent. Dan Perrine of KOGT recited the United States and Texas Pledges of Allegiance. The following business was transacted.

On consideration of extending the SARS-CoV2, COVID-19 Public Health Disaster Declaration, City Administrator Robbie Hood explained that the original declaration had been extended for 30 days at the end of March. He noted that the nation was still a long way from recovery of the COVID-19 pandemic. He commended Orange County Judge Gothia for leading the county and doing a great job during this crisis. He stated that businesses in the county would be re-opening according to Governor Abbott's plan. Mr. Hood recommended that Council extend the disaster declaration for an additional 30 days. On a motion made by Councilwoman Cynthia Adams and seconded by Mayor Pro Tem T.W. Permenter, council members unanimously voted to extend the disaster declaration for an additional 30 days.

There being no further business to transact, Mayor Pro Tem T.W. Permenter made a motion to adjourn. Councilman J. Michael Shahan seconded the motion and Mayor Mohon adjourned the meeting at 5:34p.m.
