## MINUTES

A special meeting of the City Council of the City of Pinehurst was held on May 26, 2020 at 5:30p.m. via teleconference. A quorum having been established, Mayor Dan Mohon called the meeting to order with the following council members present: Sarah McClendon, T.W. Permenter, John Zerko, J. Michael Shahan and Cynthia Adams. The following business was transacted.

On consideration of extending the SARS-CoV2, COVID-19 Public Health Disaster Declaration, Interim City Administrator Jerry Hood stated, in an effort to keep Pinehurst in consideration for future pandemic funding, he recommended extending the disaster declaration for an additional 30 days. City Administrator Robbie Hood advised that there was \$1.85 billion for the Corona Virus Relief Fund. He stated that Pinehurst would be eligible for about \$108,000 with \$24,000 being allocated up front. He informed that these funds could be used for sanitizing stations, temperature monitoring stations, and security upgrades in the Police department and the City Hall reception area to help deter the spread of the virus. On a motion made by Mayor Pro Tem T.W. Permenter and seconded by Councilwoman Cynthia Adams, council members unanimously voted to extend the disaster declaration for an additional 30 days.

There being no further business to transact, Mayor Mohon adjourned the meeting at 5:34p.m.
