

DECLARATION OF DISASTER


WHEREAS, the City of Pinehurst on the 24th day of August, 2020 is expected to suffer widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from Tropical Storm/Hurricane Laura.

WHEREAS, the City of Pinehurst Mayor has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF PINEHURST:

1. That a state of disaster is declared for the City of Pinehurst, Texas pursuant to Section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. Pursuant to Section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code; the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days of the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by City Council.
3. Pursuant to Section 418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.
4. Pursuant to Section 418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this initiates the City's Emergency Management Plan.
5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
