Complaint — TWC (texas.gov)

The Civil Rights Division conducts neutral investigations and gathers information to determine if discrimination has occurred under the Texas Fair Housing Act and rules.

These are a few of the most common housing discrimination allegations:

• The landlord would not rent to me because I have a child.

• The bank would not give me a home loan because I was pregnant.

 The property manager refused to assign me a parking space close to my apartment even though I am mobility-impaired.

**Complaint Requirements** 

To submit a housing discrimination complaint to TWC, all of these requirements must be met:

• The property must be within the state of Texas.

• The property owner, in most cases, must have more than three properties.

 The date of discrimination must have occurred within the last 365 calendar days before the date you are submitting the complaint.

• Your complaint must specify one or more of the following types of housing discrimination: race, color, national origin, religion, sex, disability or familial status.

• Your complaint must identify the housing harm.

**How to Submit a Complaint** 

You must submit your complaint within one year (365 calendar days) from the date of the discrimination. You can submit a housing discrimination. The preferred method for submitting a housing discrimination complaint form is through our <u>Housing Discrimination Inquiry Form</u>.

Complaints cannot be provided over the telephone.
