

Policy for Limb Pickup

The members of the City Council of the City of Pinehurst wish to provide additional service to the citizens of our City by providing the pickup and disposal of limbs.

Limb pick up service policy is as follows:

1. Limb pick up will be conducted each month starting on the **3rd Monday** of every month. Pick up will be all week or until all limbs have been picked up throughout the City. Once the truck has been by they will not return until the next month.
2. Limbs or trimmings shall be picked up by City crews at no cost to the Citizens with the following conditions:
 - A. Limbs cannot exceed six (6) inches in diameter.
 - B. Each single limb cannot exceed a weight of fifty (50) pounds.
 - C. Limbs must not exceed a length of ten (10) feet.
 - D. Limbs with large branches attached must be trimmed.
 - E. 6 cubic yards(limit) Any additional will need to be approved/Call for price quote.
3. Limbs for pick up must have been trimmed from trees and shrubbery from the property of the resident of the City.
4. **Limbs trimmed by a contractor will NOT be eligible for pick up by City crews. The resident contracting this service must require that the contractor dispose of the limbs they cut or trimmed.**
5. **DO NOT MIX** limbs with garbage and trash. If limbs are mixed with garbage and trash they will **NOT** be picked up.
6. Limbs must be placed at the edge of the street but must not obstruct vehicle traffic or be placed in drainage ditches or storm water drains.
7. Limbs must be clear of all power lines and trees.
