

MINUTES

A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Pinehurst was held on April 14, 2026, at 6:00pm at Pinehurst City Hall Council Room. The following council members were present: Cynthia Adams, J. Michael Shahan, Joey Vance, Troy Pierce and Greg Willis. Mayor Sarah McClendon was absent. Mayor Pro-Tem J. Michael Shahan called the meeting to order and established a quorum. Mayor J. Michael Shahan gave the invocation followed by the reciting of the United States and Texas Pledges of Allegiance. The following business was transacted.

On the motion made by Councilman Troy Pierce and seconded by Councilwoman Cynthia Adams, council members unanimously voted to approve the minutes of the Regular Session held on March 10, 2026.

There were no citizen comments.

Presentations were given to Tracy James and Lacey Hall for their continued volunteering and support of our animal shelter.

Presentation was given to Officer Alex Williams of the Pinehurst Police Department for going above and beyond the call of duty.

Presentation was given to Trooper Kolbie Sowell to honor his graduation from the Texas Department of Public Safety Academy.

City Attorney Tommy Gunn administered the Oath of Office to the Assistant Fire Chief Michael Moses.

City Administrator Report, City Administrator, Robbie Hood stated that the Spring Cleanup, April 11, 2026 went well and filled up almost (2) 40yd dumpsters. There will be Shred it Day, April 18, 2026. Mr. Hood stated that he has spoken to Republic and instead of having the spring clean up Republic will give us (4) 40 yard rolls for free each year and the City will pick up Bulk starting the 3rd week of April for free to the citizens.

Mr. Hood asked for 2 members of the council to be appointed to the 2026 Police Negotiation committee. Councilman Troy Pierce and Greg Willis were appointed to this committee.

On the action to approve additional local funds for the City of Pinehurst's GLO CDBG-DR (24-067-012-E199) Sewer System Improvements Construction Change Order #2 in the amount of \$16,500.00, Councilman Troy Pierce made a motion to approve the local funds in the amount of \$16,500.00. Councilman Joey Vance seconded the motion and the motion unanimously carried.
