

MINUTES

A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Pinehurst was held on February 10, 2026, at 6:00pm at Pinehurst City Hall Council Room. The following council members were present: Cynthia Adams, J. Michael Shahan, Joey Vance, and Greg Willis. Councilman Troy Pierce was absent. Mayor Sarah McClendon called the meeting to order and established a quorum. Councilman Greg Willis gave the invocation followed by the reciting of the United States and Texas Pledges of Allegiance. The following business was transacted.

On the motion made by Mayor Pro-Tem J. Michael Shahan and seconded by Councilman Greg Willis, council members unanimously voted to approve the minutes of the Regular Session held on January 13 2026.

There were citizen comments by Levi Nelson from Republic Services and Jimmy Davidson from Texas Stage Event Rentals.

On consideration of approving an application submitted by Oscar Yupaniqui Concha to place a manufactured home on property located at 3518 Redbird Street, Councilman Joey Vance made a motion to approve the placement of a mobile home at 3518 Redbird Street and Councilman Greg Willis seconded the motion and the motion unanimously carried.

On approving an Ordinance authorizing participation with other Energy Service Area Cities (Coalition of Cities) and representation by the Lawton Law Firm P.C. in the matters concerning Energy Texas, Inc. at the Public Utility Commission of Texas in 2026, City Attorney Tommy Gunn read the Ordinance in its entirety. Councilman Joey Vance made a motion to approve the Ordinance and Councilwoman Cynthia Adams seconded the motion and the motion unanimously carried.


On approving the Pinehurst Volunteer Fire Department By-Laws, City Administrator Robbie Hood requested that this be tabled until the March Meeting.

On approving a resolution authorizing the submission of the rifle body armor grant program FY2027 to the Office of the Governor, City Attorney Tommy Gunn read the resolution in its entirety. Councilman Greg Willis made a motion to approve the resolution and Councilman Joey Vance seconded the motion and the motion unanimously carried.

On approving budget amendments for FY 2025-2026, Mrs. Andreu stated that the amendments were for the reimbursement and city portion of the Body Worn Cameras and to change city emails to a .GOV. Mayor Pro-Tem J. Michael Shahan made a motion to accept the budget amendments and Councilwoman Cynthia Adams seconded the motion and the motion unanimously carried.

There being no further business to transact, Councilman Joey Vance made a motion to adjourn, and Councilman Greg Willis seconded the motion and the unanimously carried. Mayor Sarah McClendon adjourned the meeting at 6:23 p.m.
